Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What information do I need to apply for the scholarship?

A: You must submit: an application, proof of enrollment, and your essay.

Q: What constitutes "proof of enrollment"?

A: Proof of Enrollment is an official transcript that lists the classes for which you are registered or an enrollment verification letter from the college. Ask your college or university admissions office to send the enrollment verification letter directly to the David F. Talevi Foundation, P.O. Box 67, Wells, ME 04090. Let them know the deadline! A copy of your class schedule/transcript for the fall semester would also be acceptable.

Q: Can I apply again if I wasn't selected previously?

A: YES, absolutely! Please submit an application, proof of enrollment and a **new** essay. If you are a previous grantee, you are not eligible to receive a second scholarship.

Q: Can I apply if I am currently in college?

A: YES. You are eligible for the scholarship if you are a child (age 17 to 25) of a seasonal resident at Sea-Vu, Sea-Vu South, or Sea-Vu West. Even if you have completed a few semesters and are still going to college, you can apply. Previous grantees are not eligible to receive a second scholarship.

Q: What is the deadline for applying?

A: The deadline for applying to the 2017 Happy Camper Scholarship is August 28, 2017.

Q: When are the scholarships awarded?

A: The Foundation Scholarship Committee makes every effort to award the \$1,000 one-time grants in early September. You will be notified in person or by phone.
